October 19-20 **Barcelona, Spain**

Marvel at Gaudi's awe-inspiring masterpieces—the unfinished Church of La Sagrada Familia and La Pedrera. A worthwhile visit is the Picasso Museum with over 3000 pieces of his work. Take a break in a café along Las Ramblas and enjoy the bustling scene and colorful street performers.
